Logistical Quiz: Group Planting

Can you work out what each person took to the show, what species, how many trees in their planting and when each was pruned?

- 1) One of the members took to the show a group of nine trees that were pruned at sunset.
- 2) It was Greg who brought along cedars.
- 3) The even number of trees, that was pruned at sunrise by Ian, was greater than the number of trees in Geraldine's planting.
- 4) Someone turned up at the show with a pot of seven maples.
- 5) The number of trees pruned at noon was smaller than the hornbeam group.
- 6) Valerie, who had eight trees in her group, is not the member who pruned the pines in the mid afternoon.
